
The ASRT Board of Directors was pleased to receive your letter indicating that the HSRT has taken a position of neutrality on the CARE bill. As we have said, the ASRT is not seeking a conflict with HSRT. We, too, would like to put this matter behind us, but the HSRT Web site still contains material stating opposition to the CARE bill. In addition, the publication *Advance for Imaging and Radiation Therapy Professionals* continues to publicize articles with the same message.

In order to close the chapter on this issue and demonstrate your stance of neutrality, we request that you take the following steps by March 15, 2006:

- Remove the anti-CARE bill material from your Web site.
- Inform Roland Clements and Cory Ishihara in writing of the neutral position HSRT has taken on the CARE bill and that they do not speak for the HSRT on this matter.
- Inform *Advance* in writing that the HSRT has taken a neutral position on the CARE legislation.

The ASRT values its relationship with HSRT and looks forward to future collegial relations.
